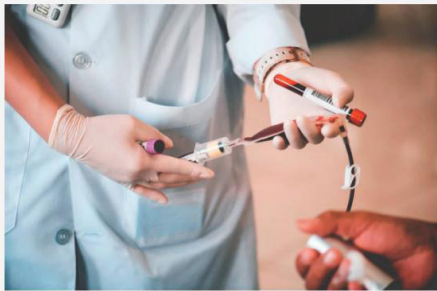


RITE NOW @ ROP
